WPG EXEC VOTE RECOMMENDATION

At the Executive Board Meeting on April 9th, 2026, a motion was made for the Executives of Winnipeg local to recommend NO for the ratification vote. This motion was passed but it was not a unanimous decision: two officers registered their dissent and one officer abstained.

Rationale for both YES and NO votes will be published soon.

WEBSITE UPDATE

The communications committee has been working on updating the website. New information has been added as well as the previous Update Issues. More changes to come soon!

VRTO

“Vehicle Required To Operate”. This is Canada Post’s vehicle sharing program. It will be implemented beginning at NED on April 13, 2026. Here are a few points noted during the Consultation with CPC:

- CPC has indicated there are enough vehicles for every route, but specific vehicles will not be assigned to each route
- CPC’s position is each route has a preferred vehicle type, they will “attempt” to match these
- Supervisors will hand out keys when carriers are ready to depart
- Vehicle types will be colour coded and parked in Zones.
- Vehicles will assigned daily newest to oldest
- Keys are handed out daily first come, first serve
- The older Transits will be replaced with new Right Hand Drives when they are out of commission
- CPC has noted they are requesting vehicles be refueled every Thursday
- EOD Supervisor will place keys back into the locked cabinet
- Damage to vehicle to be reported daily
- Vehicles to be emptied and cleaned out daily

NEXT GMM

The next GMM date has been changed to May 2, 2026 at 9:00am at the Bronx Community Centre. On the agenda: Regular Order of Business, New Notices of Motion, Committee Elections, Election of Delegates to CLC Convention.

UNION MGMT CONSULTATIONS - WMPP

Issues noted in consultation on April 2, 2026:

- CPC’s position is that cross sectioning will become the “new norm”. The Union noted the CA must be followed. If you believe that CPC has not followed the CA, seek out a shop steward
- Eclipse: If you missed your eclipse call, reach out to PC&R. If the spots have not been filled yet, you can still accept a call
- Your supervisors cannot force you to amend your break times. This can be done VOLUNTARILY if asked.
