STDP- H&S MINUTE

Many members are deemed to be in non-support of STDP because medical information is missing or not detailed enough. At the end of section B on the attending physicians report there is a section labeled treatment. This section needs to be very detailed and note Details of treatment plan and Prognosis for recovery.

At the top of section C there is a section "Describe the patient's condition in terms of symptomology". This section also needs to be very specific and note a complete list of symptoms and associated severity consistent with the diagnosis, Copies of any relevant test results or investigative reports or clinical chart notes relevant to this claim.

Also, at the bottom of section C there is a section that looks like a modified duties form. This section needs to be filled out to support whatever the doctor is saying that is going on.

Other phrases Canada Life uses for non-support are:

- Medical information received does not indicate that you are unable to function and perform the essential or regular duties of your own occupation, or appropriate alternative occupation, with or without accommodation at Canada Post.
- Your primary diagnosis is a mental health condition, and while the presence of symptoms is acknowledged, there are no clinical observations or mental status exams to corroborate the severity of these symptoms or the severity of the impact these symptoms may be having on your ability to function.
- While it is understood that your functional capacity may be limited due to this secondary chronic shoulder issue, it is not clear how you became totally disabled from work.

And the lists go on and on that is why it is very important to have very detailed objective medical.
