## TOWN HALL MEETING

## CHURCH CMB CONVERSION

The Community Mailbox implementation date has been pushed back to October 19, 2026. A date for the Consultation to discuss what will happen to the displaced employees has not been scheduled yet. Once we know what the plan is, you will know. You will not be laid off or fired.

Please read Article 53 in your Urban Collective Agreement. This is about your job security. A few important clauses are 53.01 and 53.02:

53.01- There shall be no lay-off of any regular employee who was employed in the bargaining unit as of June 1, 2020 provided the employee agrees to be displaced to another position in accordance with the procedure set forth hereinafter. The same shall apply to any other employee who becomes a regular employee after June 1, 2020 and who has five (5) years or more of continuous employment.

53.02 - A regular employee not covered by clause 53.01 will not be laid off provided the employee agrees to be displaced to another position in accordance with the procedure set forth hereinafter.

If you have any questions, reach out to a shop steward or call the local.

## UNION MGMT CONSULTATIONS - C/D

Issues noted in consultation on April 21, 2026:

- LCAs should only be pulled off their duties and sent out to deliver as a last resort
- Bid results will now be printed by management and posted in the depots
- Route assessments changing and failure to provide updated route kits
- Carriers not being paid for OT travel time
- Warning cards to be added to sorted mail
- Floor talks regarding CMB hazards will occur soon
