RETIRING SOON?

If you want to use your 5th and 6th pre-retirement leave weeks in the same year that you retire, you must take it:

- BEFORE March *and* AFTER your birthday or anniversary date (whichever is later)

For example: Your birthday is in November, your Anniversary date is August. You need to take your 5th and 6th weeks of pre-retirement in December.

Article 19.12 (g). This article uses the words "termination of employment" which also refers to your retirement date.

Reminder that all unused pre-retirement weeks WILL NOT be paid out once you retire. Use them or lose them!

If your pre-retirement leave lands on a designated paid holiday, you are entitled to an alternate day at the end of the week. For example: your week is on the same week as Christmas Eve and Christmas day? You get the next Monday and Tuesday off as well! Make sure your staffing Supervisor is aware of this and corrects it if you are not given those extra days.

If you have any questions about pre-retirement leaves, please call the local office or ask to speak to a steward on the work floor.

UNION MGMT CONSULTATIONS - C/D

Issues noted in consultation on July 21, 2026:

- If meeting with a steward, staffing needs to cover part of your route equivalent to the time spent
- Working in the heat. Use 33.05 if needed for your safety
- Updating Customer Pick Up time values after contract renewals post-strike
- VRTO waiting times and vehicle repairs
- Sunken CMBs: let your supervisors know now so it can be fixed before winter
- Header sheets: missing CPUs and SLBs
- Non-Carryover Personal days should be converted to hours
