CROSS-SECTIONING PROCEDURES

This is the following agreed upon procedure for cross-sectioning at the WMPP.

1. Casuals and Temps are moved out of the section first
2. Unassigned Relief Part-time are second
3. Unassigned Relief Full-time are third
4. Volunteers are fourth
5. Lastly, members are chosen in reverse seniority starting with the least senior, regardless of part-time or full-time status
